- 1. Presentation of proposal and rationale (see proposal document) by Eben A. Fernando Heldreth
- 2. Sight-reading adjudication training is nonexistent
- 3. Sight-reading selection is currently decided upon the sight-reading judge, traditionally the difficulty level was selected one grade-level below required literature selection. This seems to be inconsistent across the state and needs to be unified.
- 4. The rubrics should indicate the things we value. If we value more musicality and artistry, then our rubric and evaluation form should show that. Specifically in sight-reading, musicality is lightly weighted.
- 5. If the sight-reading judge is choosing the literature, then they should be a certified judge or have some training.
- 6. We should consider having multiple sight-reading judges at the state contest.
